## So how do people sign up for assistance at the Community Center?

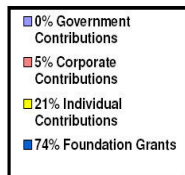
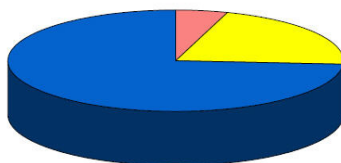

The Food Pantry and Food Stamps, however, require that applicants provide proof of identity, proof of residence and proof of income in order to enroll in these programs.

## How much do people pay for services at the Community Center?

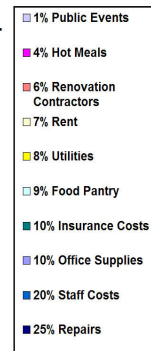
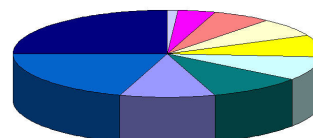
All assistance provided at the Community Center is free.
