How do I sign up for help at the Community Center?

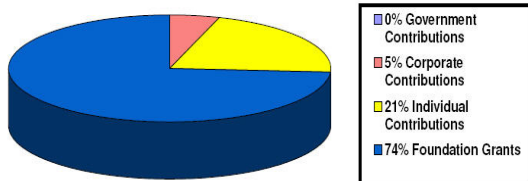
The Community Center is open to the public every Monday—Friday from 10 AM—5 PM. Not every service is available every day, so please phone us at 504-281-2512 or check the calendar at www.ccstb.org to see what weekdays the services you need are offered. For most services, you can simply come to the Community Center and get assistance right away. For the Food Pantry and Food Stamps, however, you will need to bring proof of identity, proof of residence and proof of income in order to sign up for these programs.

How much does it cost?

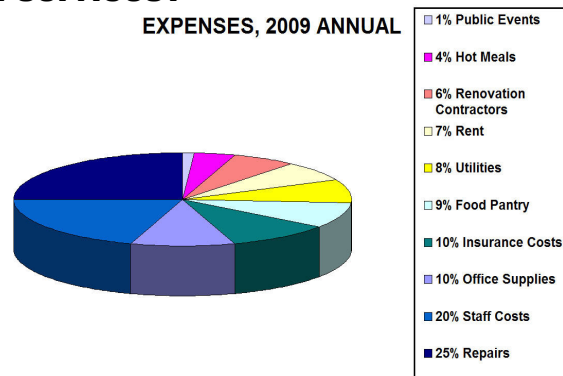
All assistance provided at the Community Center is free.
